Hi my name is John Stiles and I am submitting my comments to the House Select Committee on Mass Violence and Community Safety Hearing on duty 4. Before I go on to explain my pro advocacy position for gun rights and the absolute right to Keep and Bear Arms guarantee under the 2nd Amendment, I would like to give a little primer of who I am and where I originally come from. I am a first generation immigrant from South Korea. I became fully Naturalized when I was a young teenager. I remember that day well. I remember my hands over my heart and swearing my allegiance to America and to the US Constitution. At that time I didn't understand the full implications of what I did that day or understood the true meaning and history of the US Constitution or the United States History itself but over time I began slowly to appreciate the Grandeur and Glorious History of it. And I learn just how lucky I am and privilege to live in these United States. I feel I had won the world wide lottery jackpot. America is truly the Land of Free and Home of the Brave.

However today I feel like many newly naturalized immigrants and native born Americans, I feel America is at perilous crossroads and slowing approaching to a dangerous tipping point in which if crossed cannot return from the dark abyss. The danger is Secular Humanism and its many derivations like Atheism, Socialism, and Communism. My concerns here is not only here in America but my original birth country of South Korea. Moon Jae-in, South Korean President just almost won a super majority in the recent elections on April 15, 2020. His Democratic party is Leftist Progressive party of South Korea.
