**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
INTRODUCE LEGISLATION
RELATING TO SPECIAL
DISTRICT**

Pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, this is to give notice of intent to introduce in the 86th Texas Legislature, Regular Session, a bill to be entitled "An Act relating to providing road powers to Williamson County Municipal Utility District No. 21, of Williamson County, Texas; providing authority to issue bonds and impose taxes." The bill would give the district the powers of a road district under Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, and the authority to issue bonds for road projects and to levy taxes for payment of such bonds. The District is located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Georgetown in Williamson County, Texas.
