





## PUBLIC NOTICE

### **Notice of Sutton County Underground Water Conservation District's Intent to Apply for Passage of a Local Law**

Sutton County Underground Water Conservation District, 301 S. Crockett Ave, Sonora 76950 (the "District") hereby gives notice of its intent to apply to the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas, currently in Regular Session, to amend the District's enabling act, Act of May 17, 1985, 69th Leg., R.S., ch. 377, 1985 Tex. Gen Laws 1463, 1465 by changing the sentence of Sec. 8886.051 to read "The boundaries of the district are coextensive with the boundaries of Sutton County," and deleting "other than the territory in Sections 60, 67, 90, Block No. A, HE&WTRyCoSurvey, Sutton County,". The purpose of this language is to include the three sections that will be annexed into the District.

This notice is given in accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section 57 and Article XVI, Section 59 (d) of the Texas Constitution and Section 313.002 of the Texas Government code.

Gen Laws 1463, 1465 by deleting the final sentence of Sec. 12(b), which reads "The tax approved under this subsection may not exceed five cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation," and deleting the final sentence of Act of May 15, 2017, 85th Leg., R.S., ch. 869, § 1.04, sec. 8886.201(b), 2017 Tex. Gen. Laws 3586, 3619, which reads "The tax approved under this subsection may not exceed five cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation."
