

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO
INTRODUCE A BILL**

Pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, notice is hereby given of the intention to apply to the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas at its regular session in Austin, Texas for the introduction of a bill, the substance of the contemplated law being as follows:

An act relating to the creation of the Grayson County Municipal Utility District No. 5; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds.

The Act proposes to create a conservation and reclamation district to be known as Grayson County Municipal Utility District No. 5, being approximately 244 acres in Grayson County, Texas, more particularly described as follows:

Approximately 244 acres of land in Grayson County, Texas located northeast of the corner of Calk Road and Farm to Market Road 121.

The District's creation is subject to approval at a confirmation election.

All interested persons will, therefore, take notice of the matters and facts set out in the foregoing statement of the substance of the contemplated laws as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas.
