





NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION AND INTENT TO OBTAIN WATER QUALITY PERMIT

PROPOSED PERMIT NO. WQ0019745001

APPLICATION: Golden Shimmer's Realty Inc., 1905 Campbell Road, Houston, Texas 77052, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for proposed Great Willow Discharge Effluent System (TCEQES) Permit No. WQ0019745001 (EPA ID No. TX0913478) to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater effluent to an existing daily average flow of 950,000 gallons per day of the domestic wastewater treatment facility which located approximately 2,450 feet northwest of the intersection of Theaker Street and U.S. Highway 290 in Harris County, Texas 77047. The discharge point will be from the plant site to a detention pond, thence to a canal of Harris County Flood Control District thence to Cypress Creek. TCEQ received this application on November 26, 2018. The permit application is available for viewing and copying at Cypress College Library 4191 Barber Cypress Road, Cypress, Texas. ADDITIONAL NOTICE: TCEQ's Executive Director has determined the application is administratively complete and will conduct a technical review of the application. After technical review of the application is complete, the Executive Director may require a draft permit and may take a preliminary decision on the application. Notice of the application and final permit decision will be published and mailed to those who are on the community-wide mailing list and to those who are on the mailing list for this application. That notice will contain the deadline for submitting public comment.

PUBLIC COMMENT /PUBLIC MEETING: You may submit public comment on any request a public meeting on this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local government. A public meeting is a consented case hearing.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING: After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will conduct a timely comment and response to all relevant and material or significant public comments. The Executive Director will directly refer to a contested case hearing the response to comments, and the Executive Director's decision on the application, will be mailed by overnight mail to all public commenters and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting a contested case hearing. The Executive Director's decision and for requesting a contested case hearing. A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, telephone number, application name and proposed permit number; the location and address of your property; a written objection to the proposed facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility; a way and comment to the general public; a list of all documents of law that you submit during the comment period and the commenter; (b) you request a contested case hearing. If the request for a contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address no individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility; no activity provided by the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity explain how and why the member would be affected; and provide how the information you submit is relevant to the contested case hearing.
