Relating to remedies after certain casualty losses to residential rental premises.

Relating to the eligibility of an injured employee for lifetime income benefits under the workers' compensation system.

Relating to the amount of civil penalties the attorney general may seek to recover under the Deceptive Trade Practices-Consumer Protection Act.
