HB 27 Canales | et al.
Relating to increasing the criminal penalty for assault or aggravated assault of a federal law enforcement officer.

HB 63 Moody | et al.
Relating to the civil and criminal penalties for possession of certain small amounts of marihuana and an exception to prosecution for possession of associated drug paraphernalia; creating a criminal offense.

HB 86 Martinez | et al.
Relating to prohibiting the reckless discharge of a firearm; creating a criminal offense.

HB 446 Moody | et al.
Relating to the criminal consequences of engaging in certain conduct with respect to certain instruments designed, made, or adapted for use in striking a person with a fist.

HB 521 Dutton
Relating to the charging instrument in the prosecution of the offense of resisting arrest.

HB 667 King, Ken

Relating to the prosecution of and punishment for the offense of sexual assault; enhancing a criminal penalty.

HB 760 Wu

Relating to the punishment for the criminal offense of theft involving a package delivered to or collected from a residential or commercial property; increasing a criminal penalty.

HB 1028 Guillen

Relating to increasing the criminal penalties for certain offenses committed in a disaster area or an evacuated area.
