Relating to the administration and operation of the state's programs for paying, prepaying, or saving toward the costs of attending an institution of higher education, including the powers and duties of the Prepaid Higher Education Tuition Board.

Relating to drug or alcohol overdose awareness and response training for residential advisors and officers of student organizations at public or private institutions of higher education.

Relating to the exemption of tuition and laboratory fees at public institutions of higher education for certain paramedics.

Relating to the creation of the advisory council on postsecondary education for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

HB 4003 Sheffield  
Relating to a study by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board concerning a shortage of primary care physicians in this state.

Relating to meeting the graduate medical education needs of medical degree programs offered or proposed by public institutions of higher education.

Relating to reports of sexual assault made to public or private institutions of higher education.
