Relating to criminal history record checks for nurse aides and applicants for listing on the nurse aide registry; authorizing a fee.

HB 3549 Rose

Relating to a prohibition on certain inpatient hospital care limitations under the STAR+PLUS Medicaid managed care program.

HB 3746 Krause

Relating to access to certain health records and information by certain individuals regarding a child placed in foster care.

HB 4192 Klick

Relating to claims and overpayment recoupment processes imposed on health care providers under Medicaid and other public benefits programs.

HB 4354 Phelan

Relating to prevention and early intervention programs and practices.

HB 4400 Johnson, Julie | et al.

Relating to the establishment of a pilot program to create additional housing for certain individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability through a Medicaid waiver program.

HJR 141 Johnson, Julie

Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds for conducting a program to create additional housing for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability.

HB 4450 González, Mary

Relating to the regulation of child-care facilities and registered family homes providing services to children with disabilities or special needs.
