HB 345 Holland  
Relating to the automatic issuance of a personal identification certificate to a person 60 years of age or older whose driver's license has been surrendered or revoked.

HB 629 Landgraf  
Relating to establishing a protective order registry and the duties of courts in regard to the registry.

HB 830 Israel  
Relating to the release by a peace officer of certain individuals suspected of the offense of public intoxication.

HB 1078 Oliverson  
Relating to waiving certain driver's license and handgun license fees for applicants who hold a certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

HB 1145 Krause  
Relating to the repeal of the driver responsibility program and the amount and allocation of state traffic fine funds; authorizing and increasing criminal fines; eliminating program surcharges.

HB 1355 Button  
Relating to the execution of a search warrant for taking a blood specimen from certain persons in certain intoxication offenses.

HB 1844 Guillen  
Relating to content, issuance, and change of driver's licenses and other forms of identification issued by the Department of Public Safety, including automatic voter registration.

HB 2305 Morrison  
Relating to a work group on enhancing the training and credentialing of emergency management personnel.
