Relating to the language acquisition of children eight years of age or younger who are deaf or hard of hearing.

SB 933 Bettencourt | et al.

Relating to the creation of the office of inspector general at the Texas Education Agency to investigate the administration of public education.

SB 1230 Bettencourt

Relating to the reporting of private school educator misconduct.

SB 1231 Bettencourt

Relating to providing certain public and private school administrators with information regarding certain child abuse and neglect investigations and allegations.

SB 1256 Bettencourt

Relating to employing, terminating, and reporting the misconduct of public school personnel and related entity personnel, including creating a registry of persons ineligible for hire; creating criminal offenses.

SB 1476 Bettencourt

Relating to the requirement for certain administrators of certain educational entities to report certain educator misconduct to the State Board for Educator Certification.
