Relating to authorizing school districts to reimburse under the Foundation School Program private employers for paid internships provided to certain students in career and technology education programs in the district.

**SB 2201** Fallon  
Relating to local goals for public education and governance of local school districts.

**SB 2265** Taylor  
Relating to the assignment of performance ratings to school districts and school district campuses.

**SB 2283** Campbell  
Relating to the eligibility of persons convicted of certain offenses to serve as a member of a board of trustees of a school district.
