to and used by certain schools.

**HB 1885** Bonnen, Greg | et al. SP: Zaffirini Relating to the waiver of penalties and interest if an error by a mortgagee results in failure to pay an ad valorem tax.

**HB 2159** Meyer | et al. SP: Paxton Relating to the correction of an ad valorem tax appraisal roll.

**HB 2111** Pacheco | et al. SP: Flores Relating to the period for which a school district's participation in certain tax increment financing reinvestment zones may be taken into account in determining the total taxable value of property in the school district.

**HB 2942** Guillen | et al. SP: Flores Relating to the eligibility of land to continue to be appraised for ad valorem tax purposes as qualified open-space land if the land is temporarily used for sand mining operations; authorizing a fee.

**HB 3384** Shine SP: Bettencourt Relating to the authority of the comptroller to conduct a limited-scope review of an appraisal district located in an area declared by the governor to be a disaster area.
