Relating to the prosecution of the offense of taking or attempting to take a weapon from certain officers, investigators, employees, or officials.

SB 1879 Schwertner
Relating to firearms training for county jailers.

SB 2114 West
Relating to certain duties of peace officers and law enforcement agencies concerning certain information subject to disclosure to a defendant.

SB 2381 Hughes
Relating to the places where certain knives are prohibited.
