SB 562 Zaffirini
Relating to the delivery of certain mental health information regarding a defendant transferred from a county to the custody of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, the commitment of certain defendants for competency restoration, and the use of telepsychiatry in determining whether a defendant is manifestly dangerous before commitment.

SB 583 Hinojosa
Relating to the appointment of a local public defender's office to represent indigent defendants in criminal cases.

SB 693 West
Relating to the reporting of certain information involving family violence offenses.

SB 1164 Rodríguez
Relating to the disposition of an item bearing a counterfeit trademark seized in connection with a criminal offense.

SB 1268 Watson
Relating to a statement presented in a criminal case by a victim, close relative of a deceased victim, or guardian of a victim.

SB 1649 Kolkhorst
Relating to assistance with the establishment and oversight of public defenders' offices and a review of criminal defense attorney's fees by the Texas Indigent Defense Commission.

SB 1697

Whitmire

Relating to the requirements for a change of name for a person with a final felony conviction or a person required to register as a sex offender.

SB 1700

Whitmire

Relating to the discharge of a prisoner from a county jail.

Miles

Relating to compensation under the Crime Victims' Compensation Act for certain expenses.
