Relating to inquest summary reports and the preservation of evidence collected in the course of an inquest.

Relating to the creation of truancy masters for Bell County.

Relating to reimbursement for a certain portion of a forensic medical examination of a sexual assault survivor and for the evidence collection kit required for the examination.

Relating to the prosecution of and punishment for the offense of sexual assault; enhancing a criminal penalty.

Relating to the execution of a search warrant for taking a blood specimen from certain persons in certain intoxication offenses.

Relating to statewide policies and practices, personnel training, evidence collection and preservation, and data collection and analysis regarding the prevention, investigation, and prosecution of sexual assault and other sex offenses.

Relating to the creation of a family violence pretrial diversion pilot program in Bexar County.

Relating to the transfer of certain state property from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice to DeWitt County.

Relating to the powers and duties of the office of independent ombudsman for the Texas Juvenile Justice Department.

Relating to the apprehension of a child after escape from a secure juvenile facility or violation of conditions of release under supervision.

Relating to the office of the inspector general of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department.
