| 11 | (a) In this section, "International Swimming Pool and Spa Code"      |
| 12 | means the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code promulgated by    |
| 13 | the International Code Council.                                      |
| 14 | (b) To protect the public health, safety, and welfare, the           |
| 15 | International Swimming Pool and Spa Code, as it existed on May 1,    |
| 16 | 2019, is adopted as the municipal swimming pool and spa code in this |
| 17 | state.   |
| 18 | (c) The International Swimming Pool and Spa Code applies to          |
| 19 | all construction, alteration, remodeling, enlargement, and repair    |
| 20 | of swimming pools and spas in a municipality that elects to regulate |
