A fee may not be charged under Section 54.5192, Education Code, as added by this Act, before the 2019 fall semester. 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 13

14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
