A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

-	1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to establishing a joint select committee to study the
- 3 feasibility and sustainability of providing a cost-of-living
- 4 adjustment applicable to certain benefits paid by the Teacher
- 5 Retirement System of Texas.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "committee" means the
- 8 joint select committee established under Section 2 of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 2. JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE. (a) A joint select
- 10 committee is established for the purposes of this Act and is
- 11 composed of the following members:
- 12 (1) two members of the senate appointed by the
- 13 lieutenant governor;
- 14 (2) two members of the house of representatives
- 15 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 16 (3) one member of the public who is appointed by the
- 17 lieutenant governor from lists of names submitted by stakeholder
- 18 groups; and
- 19 (4) one member of the public who is appointed by the
- 20 speaker of the house of representatives from lists of names
- 21 submitted by stakeholder groups.
- (b) The lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of
- 23 representatives shall make the appointments required under
- 24 Subsection (a) of this section as soon as possible after the

- 1 effective date of this Act, but not later than November 1, 2021.
- 2 (c) If a vacancy occurs, the appropriate appointing officer
- 3 shall appoint a person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired
- 4 term in the same manner as the original appointment.
- 5 SECTION 3. PRESIDING OFFICER; MEETINGS. (a) The
- 6 lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of representatives
- 7 shall jointly select the presiding officer of the committee.
- 8 (b) The committee shall convene at the call of the presiding 9 officer.
- 10 SECTION 4. COOPERATION OF STATE AGENCY, DEPARTMENT, OR
- 11 OFFICE. If needed to perform the duties of the committee, the
- 12 committee may request the assistance of a state agency, department,
- 13 or office. The state agency, department, or office shall provide
- 14 the committee with the requested assistance.
- 15 SECTION 5. EXPENSES. (a) Each member of the committee is
- 16 entitled to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses
- 17 incurred in performing committee duties.
- 18 (b) Each legislative member is entitled to reimbursement
- 19 from the appropriate fund of the member's respective house.
- 20 (c) Each public member is entitled to reimbursement from
- 21 funds appropriated to the committee.
- 22 SECTION 6. COMMITTEE POWERS AND DUTIES; STUDY. (a) The
- 23 committee shall study the feasibility and sustainability of
- 24 providing a cost-of-living adjustment payable to annuitants
- 25 receiving a retirement benefit annuity under the Teacher Retirement
- 26 System of Texas. The study must seek to identify and recommend a
- 27 financial structure capable of providing the cost-of-living

- 1 adjustment.
- 2 (b) The committee has all other powers and duties provided
- 3 to a special or select committee by the rules of the senate and
- 4 house of representatives, by Subchapter B, Chapter 301, Government
- 5 Code, and by policies of the senate and house committees on
- 6 administration.
- 7 SECTION 7. REPORT. Not later than September 1, 2022, the
- 8 committee shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor,
- 9 and the speaker of the house of representatives a report of the
- 10 committee's findings and recommendations under this Act.
- 11 SECTION 8. ABOLITION OF COMMITTEE; EXPIRATION. The
- 12 committee is abolished and this Act expires September 15, 2022.
- 13 SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 14 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 15 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 16 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 17 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 18 last day of the legislative session.
