A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to accommodating a voter unable to enter a polling place.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 64.009, Election Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
- 6 (e) An election officer shall designate a parking space at
- 7 each polling place for voting under this section. The parking space
- 8 may not be one designated specifically for persons with
- 9 disabilities. The parking space must be clearly marked with a sign
- 10 indicating that the space is reserved for use by a voter who is
- 11 unable to enter the polling place.
- 12 (f) An election officer shall ensure that a voter has the
- 13 <u>ability to request assistance from an election officer at the</u>
- 14 polling place from inside a vehicle parked in the space designated
- 15 under Subsection (e) through use of:
- 16 (1) a telephone number displayed on the sign in large
- 17 font readable from the vehicle that the voter may text or call; or
- 18 (2) a button the voter may use to access an intercom
- 19 system.
- SECTION 2. Section 104.004(e), Election Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- (e) If the voter is physically unable to enter the early
- 23 voting polling place without personal assistance or a likelihood of
- 24 injuring the voter's health, the clerk shall deliver the balloting

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- 1 materials to the voter at the polling place entrance or curb
- 2 following the procedures prescribed by Section 64.009.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 8 legislative session.
