3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 64.012, Election Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
6	follows:
7	(a) A person commits an offense if the person:
8	(1) votes or attempts to vote in an election \underline{if} [\underline{in}
9	<pre>which] the person knows:</pre>
10	(A) of particular circumstances that make the
11	person [is] not eligible to vote in the election; and
12	(B) that those circumstances make the person not
13	eligible to vote in the election;
14	(2) knowingly votes or attempts to vote more than once
15	in an election;
16	(3) knowingly votes or attempts to vote a ballot
17	belonging to another person, or by impersonating another person; or
18	(4) knowingly marks or attempts to mark any portion of
19	another person's ballot without the consent of that person, or
20	without specific direction from that person how to mark the ballot.
21	(c) It is an exception to the application of Subsection
22	(a)(1) that the person:
23	(1) voted or attempted to vote a provisional ballot in

- 1 (2) did not knowingly make a false statement on the
- 2 affidavit executed by the person in accordance with Section 63.011
- 3 with intent to deceive.
- 4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 5 offense under Section 64.012(a)(1), Election Code, regardless of
- 6 whether the offense was committed before, on, or after the
- 7 effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 9 last day of the legislative session.
