A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to the use of demand response technology to reduce energy
 3 consumption in state-owned buildings.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 2166.4021 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 2166.4021.</u> DEMAND RESPONSE TECHNOLOGY FOR STATE
- 8 BUILDINGS. (a) The commission by rule shall adopt guidelines for
- 9 the required use of demand response technology in state-owned
- 10 buildings, including buildings otherwise exempt from this chapter
- 11 under Section 2166.003, to reduce energy consumption for the
- 12 <u>buildings</u> in response to energy supply constraints.
- 13 (b) The guidelines adopted under Subsection (a) must
- 14 require the remote reduction of building energy consumption by at
- 15 least 30 percent during:

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- (1) weather or energy emergencies; and
- 17 (2) peak demand days as determined by the independent
- 18 <u>organization certified under Section 39.151, Utilities Code.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. The Texas Facilities Commission shall adopt the
- 20 guidelines required by Section 2166.4021, Government Code, as added
- 21 by this Act, not later than February 1, 2022.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 23 last day of the legislative session.
