- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 180, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 180.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 180.010. LIMITATION ON SEVERANCE PAY FOR EMPLOYEES AND
- 8 INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS. (a) In this section, "misconduct" means
- 9 an act or omission by an employee or contractor of a political
- 10 subdivision in the performance of the employee's or contractor's
- 11 duties that the governing body of the political subdivision
- 12 determines to be misconduct. The term includes any finding of
- 13 <u>criminal conduct.</u>
- 14 (b) This section applies to an action brought against a
- 15 political subdivision by an employee or independent contractor of
- 16 the political subdivision arising from the termination of the
- 17 person's employment or contract. A court may not issue a writ of
- 18 execution or mandamus in connection with a judgment in the action if
- 19 the judgment does not comply with this section.
- 20 <u>(c) This section does not apply to a public or teaching</u>
- 21 hospital.
- 22 <u>(d) A political subdivision may not, as part of a severance</u>
- 23 package or as part of any other agreement or settlement made in
- 24 relation to the termination of a person's employment or contract as

- 1 an independent contractor, make a payment to an employee or
- 2 independent contractor if:
- 3 <u>(1)</u> the payment would:
- 4 (A) be paid from tax revenue; and
- 5 (B) exceed the amount of compensation, at the
- 6 rate at the termination of employment or the contract, the employee
- 7 or independent contractor would have been paid for 20 weeks,
- 8 excluding paid time off or accrued vacation leave; or
- 9 (2) the employee or independent contractor was
- 10 terminated for misconduct.
- 11 (e) A political subdivision shall post each severance
- 12 agreement in a prominent place on the political subdivision's
- 13 Internet website.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 180.010, Local Government Code, as added
- 15 by this Act, applies only to a contract entered into or an action
- 16 filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 18 last day of the legislative session.
