Article 7B.103, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 Art. 7B.103. ENFORCEMENT. 7 The procedure for the enforcement of a protective order under Title 4, Family Code, 8 9 applies to the fullest extent practicable to the enforcement of a protective order under this subchapter, including provisions 10 relating to findings, contents, [duration,] warning, delivery, law 11 12 enforcement duties, and modification, except that: 13 (1) the printed statement on the warning must refer to 14 the prosecution of subsequent offenses committed because of bias or 15 prejudice; a protective order issued under this subchapter 16 (2) may be effective: 17 18 (A) for the duration of the lives of the defendant and the person for whom the protective order is issued or 19 for any shorter period stated in the order; or 20 21 (B) if a period is not stated in the order, until the second anniversary of the date the order was issued; 22 23 (3) the court shall require a constable to serve a protective order issued under this subchapter; and 24

1 (4) [(3)] the clerk of the court shall forward a copy 2 of a protective order issued under this subchapter to the 3 Department of Public Safety with a designation indicating that the 4 order was issued to prevent offenses committed because of bias or 5 prejudice.

6 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 7B, Code of Criminal 7 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 7B.1035 to read as follows:

8 <u>Art. 7B.1035. RESCISSION. A person for whom a protective</u> 9 <u>order is issued under this subchapter may file at any time an</u> 10 <u>application with the court to rescind the protective order.</u>

11 SECTION 3. Section 85.025(b-3), Family Code, is amended to 12 read as follows:

13 (b-3) Subsection (b) does not apply to a protective order 14 issued under Subchapter A <u>or C</u>, Chapter 7B, Code of Criminal 15 Procedure.

16 SECTION 4. Article 7B.103, Code of Criminal Procedure, and 17 Section 85.025(b-3), Family Code, as amended by this Act, apply 18 only to a protective order for which an application is filed on or 19 after the effective date of this Act.

20 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 21 last day of the legislative session.
