A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to vehicle safety inspections for vehicles registered in
- 3 certain counties; imposing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 382.0622(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Clean Air Act fees consist of:
- 8 (1) fees collected by the commission under Sections
- 9 382.062, 382.0621, 382.202, and 382.302 and as otherwise provided
- 10 by law;
- 11 (2) \$2 from the portion of each fee collected for
- 12 inspections of vehicles other than mopeds and remitted to the state
- 13 under Sections 548.501 and 548.503, Transportation Code; [and]
- 14 (3) \$6 from the portion of each fee collected for
- 15 inspections of vehicles other than mopeds and remitted to the state
- 16 under Section 548.5035, Transportation Code; and
- 17 (4) fees collected that are required under Section 185
- 18 of the federal Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. Section 7511d).
- 19 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 20 is amended by adding Section 548.010 to read as follows:
- Sec. 548.010. INSPECTION IN ANY COUNTY PERMITTED FOR
- 22 <u>VEHICLES REGISTERED IN CERTAIN COUNTIES.</u> Notwithstanding any other
- 23 law, a vehicle inspected under Section 548.1025 may be inspected in
- 24 any county.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 548.101, Transportation Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 548.101. GENERAL ONE-YEAR INSPECTION PERIOD. Except
- 4 as provided by Sections [Section] 548.102 and 548.1025, the
- 5 department shall require an annual inspection. The department
- 6 shall set the periods of inspection and may make rules with respect
- 7 to those periods. The rules must provide that:
- 8 (1) a vehicle owner shall [may] obtain any required
- 9 inspections [an inspection] not earlier than 90 days before the
- 10 date of expiration of the vehicle's registration; and
- 11 (2) a used motor vehicle sold by a dealer, as defined
- 12 by Section 503.001, must be inspected in the 180 days preceding the
- 13 date the dealer sells the vehicle.
- 14 SECTION 4. Section 548.102(a), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) Except as provided by Section 548.1025, the [The]
- 17 initial inspection period is two years for a passenger car or light
- 18 truck that:
- 19 (1) is sold in this state or purchased by a commercial
- 20 fleet buyer described by Section 501.0234(b)(4) for use in this
- 21 state;
- 22 (2) has not been previously registered in this or
- 23 another state; and
- 24 (3) on the date of sale is of the current or preceding
- 25 model year.
- SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 27 is amended by adding Section 548.1025 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 548.1025. INSPECTION PERIOD FOR VEHICLES REGISTERED IN
- 2 CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to a vehicle that
- 3 is registered in a county that has:
- 4 (1) a population of less than 10,000; and
- 5 (2) a total area of more than 2,000 square miles.
- 6 (b) The inspection period for a vehicle described by
- 7 <u>Subsection (a) is three years.</u>
- 8 <u>(c) This section does not apply to the inspection period for</u>
- 9 a:
- 10 (1) commercial motor vehicle inspection under
- 11 Subchapter D; or
- 12 (2) motor <u>vehicle emissions inspection under</u>
- 13 Subchapter F.
- SECTION 6. Section 548.254, Transportation Code, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- Sec. 548.254. VALIDITY OF VEHICLE INSPECTION REPORT. The
- 17 department, and the conservation commission if necessary, by rule
- 18 shall establish the length of time a [A] vehicle inspection report
- 19 required by this chapter is valid [invalid after the end of the 12th
- 20 month following the month in which the report is issued].
- 21 SECTION 7. Section 548.501(a), Transportation Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) Except as provided by Sections 548.503, 548.5035, and
- 24 548.504, the fee for inspection of a motor vehicle other than a
- 25 moped is \$12.50. The fee for inspection of a moped is \$5.75.
- SECTION 8. Subchapter H, Chapter 548, Transportation Code,
- 27 is amended by adding Section 548.5035 to read as follows:

- Sec. 548.5035. FEE FOR THREE-YEAR INSPECTION OF VEHICLES
- 2 REGISTERED IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) Except as provided by
- 3 Subsection (b), the fee for inspection of a vehicle under Section
- 4 548.1<u>025 is \$23.50.</u>
- 5 (b) The fee for inspection of a moped under Section 548.1025
- 6 is \$16.75.
- 7 (c) Out of each fee for an inspection, \$16.50 shall be
- 8 remitted to the state under Section 548.509.
- 9 SECTION 9. Section 548.505(a), Transportation Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The department by rule may impose an inspection fee for
- 12 a vehicle inspected under Section 548.301(a) in addition to the fee
- 13 provided by Section 548.501, 548.502, 548.503, 548.5035, or
- 14 548.504. A fee imposed under this subsection must be based on the
- 15 costs of:
- 16 (1) providing inspections; and
- 17 (2) administering the program.
- 18 SECTION 10. Not later than March 1, 2022, the Texas
- 19 Department of Motor Vehicles shall adopt rules and update the
- 20 department's registration database and system as necessary to
- 21 ensure that an owner of a vehicle subject to Section 548.010,
- 22 Transportation Code, as added by this Act, is able to register or
- 23 renew registration of the vehicle without obtaining an annual
- 24 safety inspection of the vehicle.
- 25 SECTION 11. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 26 section, this Act takes effect April 1, 2022.
- 27 (b) Section 10 of this Act takes effect December 1, 2021.
