A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring this state to
- 2 observe daylight saving time year-round.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 74 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 74. (a) This state, if authorized by federal law,
- 7 shall observe daylight saving time year-round throughout the state.
- 8 (b) This section applies to all portions of the state,
- 9 regardless of time zone.
- 10 (c) Subsections (a) and (b) of this section apply only if
- 11 the United States Congress enacts legislation that becomes law that
- 12 <u>authorizes this state to observe daylight saving time as prescribed</u>
- 13 by this section. If such federal legislation becomes law,
- 14 Subsections (a) and (b) of this section apply beginning on the first
- 15 date, after the date that federal law takes effect, on which this
- 16 state would otherwise have switched from observing daylight saving
- 17 <u>time to observing standard time.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 2, 2021.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring this state to
- 22 observe daylight saving time year-round."
