RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Vernon Ollar of Kerr County is celebrating his 100th 2 birthday on July 26, 2021, and this joyous occasion provides a 3 fitting opportunity to recognize this esteemed member of the 4 Greatest Generation for his service during World War II; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in Moline, Illinois, in 1921, Vern Ollar grew up in neighboring Rock Island; he worked at an ordnance plant before 6 7 joining the United States Army in December 1942; after basic training with the Chemical Warfare Service at Camp Sibert in 8 Alabama, he was stationed at Camp Polk in Louisiana, with the 81st 9 Chemical Mortar Battalion, and then went on mountain maneuvers at 10 11 Camp Pickens in Virginia; he was deployed to England aboard the Capetown Castle, a converted British ocean liner, and following an 12 arduous journey, he trained for months in the frigid English 13 14 Channel in preparation for D-Day; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ollar landed on Omaha Beach on June 6, 1944, 15 with the 116th Regiment, 29th Infantry Division, in the first wave 16 of the attack; as a mortarman, he had to enter deep, icy water to 17 drag the weapons ashore while dodging enemy fire and anti-tank 18 mines; he was the gunner for his squad, which quickly took out a 19 machine gun nest; after securing the bluff tops, the division 20 advanced, and Mr. Ollar and his comrades had to seek food and 21 shelter at abandoned farmsteads; he took part in the bitter 22 23 fighting through hedgerows and proceeded across France and Belgium to Germany; for his valor at Dillingen, he received a bronze star; 24

1 toward the end of the war, he was also involved in the development 2 of radar technology to detect the origin of incoming artillery 3 rounds; and

WHEREAS, Over the course of a century, Vern Ollar has not only bravely served his nation, but has also met the challenges and opportunities of a long life with fortitude, earning the lasting respect and admiration of all who are fortunate enough to know him; now, therefore, be it
