## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT
2	relating to abortion reporting and exemptions to abortion facility
3	licensing; creating a criminal offense.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 171, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 171.009 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 171.009. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR ABORTIONS
8	PERFORMED OUTSIDE ABORTION FACILITY; CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) A
9	physician who performs an abortion at a location other than an
10	abortion facility licensed under Chapter 245 must complete and
11	submit a monthly report to the commission on each abortion
12	performed by the physician. The report must be submitted on a form
13	provided by the commission.
14	(b) The report may not identify by any means the patient.
15	(c) The report must include:
16	(1) the type of facility at which the abortion was
17	performed and the licensing status of that facility;
18	(2) the patient's year of birth, race, marital status,
19	and state and county of residence;
20	(3) the type of abortion procedure performed;
21	(4) the date the abortion was performed;
22	(5) whether the patient survived the abortion, and if
23	the patient did not survive, the cause of death;
24	(6) the probable post-fertilization age of the unborn

- 1 child based on the best medical judgment of the attending physician
- 2 at the time of the procedure;
- 3 (7) the date, if known, of the patient's last menstrual
- 4 cycle;
- 5 (8) the number of previous live births of the patient;
- 6 (9) the number of previous induced abortions of the
- 7 patient; and
- 8 (10) the county in which the abortion was performed.
- 9 (d) All information and records held by the commission under
- 10 this section are confidential and are not open records for the
- 11 purposes of Chapter 552, Government Code. That information may not
- 12 be released or made public on subpoena or otherwise, except that
- 13 release may be made:
- 14 (1) for statistical purposes, but only if a person,
- 15 patient, or physician performing an abortion is not identified;
- 16 (2) with the consent of each person, patient, and
- 17 physician identified in the information released;
- 18 (3) to medical personnel, appropriate state agencies,
- 19 or county and district courts to enforce this chapter; or
- 20 <u>(4) to appropriate state licensing boards to enforce</u>
- 21 state licensing laws.
- (e) A person commits an offense if the person violates
- 23 Subsection (b), (c), or (d). An offense under this subsection is a
- 24 Class A misdemeanor.
- 25 (f) Not later than the 15th day of each month, a physician
- 26 shall submit to the commission the report required by this section
- 27 for each abortion performed by the physician at a location other

- 1 than an abortion facility in the preceding calendar month.
- 2 (g) The commission shall establish and maintain a secure
- 3 <u>electronic reporting system for the submission of the reports</u>
- 4 required by this section. The commission shall adopt procedures to
- 5 enforce this section and to ensure that only physicians who perform
- 6 one or more abortions during the preceding calendar month are
- 7 required to file the reports under this section for that month.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 245.004, Health and Safety Code, as
- 9 amended by Chapters 198 (H.B. 2292) and 999 (H.B. 15), Acts of the
- 10 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 245.004. EXEMPTIONS FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENT. (a)
- 13 The following facilities need not be licensed under this chapter:
- 14 (1) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241 (Texas
- 15 Hospital Licensing Law); [or]
- 16 (2) the office of a physician licensed under Subtitle
- 17 B, Title 3, Occupations Code, unless the office is used
- 18 substantially for the purpose of performing [more than 50]
- 19 abortions; or
- 20 (3) an ambulatory surgical center licensed under
- 21 Chapter 243.
- (b) For purposes of this section, a facility is used
- 23 substantially for the purpose of performing abortions if the
- 24 facility:
- 25 (1) is a provider for performing:
- 26 (A) at least five [10] abortion procedures during
- 27 any month; or

- 1 (B) at least  $\underline{50}$  [ $\underline{100}$ ] abortion procedures in a
- 2 12-month period [year];
- 3 (2) operates less than 20 days in a month and the
- 4 facility, in any month, is a provider for performing a number of
- 5 abortion procedures that would be equivalent to at least five [10]
- 6 procedures in a month if the facility were operating at least 20
- 7 days in a month;
- 8 (3) holds itself out to the public as an abortion
- 9 provider by advertising by any public means, including advertising
- 10 placed in a newspaper, telephone directory, magazine, or electronic
- 11 medium, that the facility performs abortions; or
- 12 (4) applies for an abortion facility license.
- 13 (b-1) In computing the number of abortions performed for
- 14 purposes of Subsections (b)(1) and (2), an abortion performed in
- 15 <u>accordance with Section 245.016 is not included.</u>
- 16 (c) For purposes of this section, an abortion facility is
- 17 operating if the facility is open for any period of time during a
- 18 day and has on site at the facility or on call a physician available
- 19 to perform abortions.
- SECTION 3. Section 245.011(c), Health and Safety Code, as
- 21 effective September 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:
- 22 (c) The report must include:
- 23 (1) whether the abortion facility at which the
- 24 abortion is performed is licensed under this chapter;
- 25 (2) the patient's year of birth, race, marital status,
- 26 and state and county of residence;
- 27 (3) the type of abortion procedure performed;

- 1 (4) the date the abortion was performed;
- 2 (5) whether the patient survived the abortion, and if
- 3 the patient did not survive, the cause of death;
- 4 (6) the probable post-fertilization age of the unborn
- 5 child based on the best medical judgment of the attending physician
- 6 at the time of the procedure;
- 7 (7) the date, if known, of the patient's last menstrual
- 8 cycle;
- 9 (8) the number of previous live births of the patient;
- 10 (9) the number of previous induced abortions of the
- 11 patient;
- 12 (10) whether the abortion was performed or induced
- 13 because of a medical emergency and any medical condition of the
- 14 pregnant woman that required the abortion; [and]
- 15 (11) the county in which the abortion was performed;
- 16 and
- 17 (12) the information required under Sections
- 18 171.008(a) and (c).
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 245.002, Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 amended by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
- 21 (3) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
- 22 <u>Commission</u>.
- 23 SECTION 5. Section 245.0116, Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 245.0116. COMMISSION [DEPARTMENT] REPORT. (a) The
- 26 commission [department] shall publish on its Internet website a
- 27 monthly report containing aggregate data of the information in the

- 1 reports submitted under <u>Sections</u> [<u>Section</u>] <u>171.009 and</u> 245.011. <u>The</u>
- 2 report must specify the number of abortions performed in each
- 3 county during the reporting period.
- 4 (b) The <u>commission's</u> [<u>department's</u>] monthly report may not
- 5 identify by any means an abortion facility, a physician performing
- 6 the abortion, or a patient.
- 7 SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 an abortion performed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect December 1, 2021.
