## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the return of certain ballots.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 86.006, Election Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (a-1) and adding Subsection (a-2) to read as
6	follows:
7	(a-1) The voter may deliver a marked ballot in person to the
8	early voting clerk's office <u>or to another designated location</u>
9	[ <del>only</del> ] while the polls are open on election day <u>or during the early</u>
10	voting period. A voter who delivers a marked ballot in person must
11	present an acceptable form of identification described by Section
12	63.0101.
13	(a-2) The early voting clerk may designate any number of
14	suitable locations for in-person delivery of ballots.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 16 last day of the legislative session.
