- 2 relating to the signing of ballots by deputy early voting clerks.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 85.0311, Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 85.0311. DEPUTY EARLY VOTING CLERK TO SIGN BALLOTS.
- 7 (a) The <u>deputy</u> early voting clerk's <u>signature or</u> initials shall be
- 8 placed on the back of each ballot to be used at the polling place
- 9 where the deputy early voting clerk accepts voters voting by
- 10 personal appearance.
- 11 (b) The deputy early voting clerk at a polling place shall
- 12 enter the <u>signature or</u> initials <u>of the deputy early voting clerk</u> on
- 13 each ballot [or a deputy early voting clerk shall stamp a facsimile
- 14 of the initials on each ballot].
- 15 (c) The signing of ballots under this section need not be
- 16 completed before the polls open, but an unsigned ballot may not be
- 17 made available for selection by a voter.
- 18 <u>(d) The duties of a deputy early voting clerk and the</u>
- 19 placement of a signature or initials required by this section may
- 20 not be satisfied using automation of any type.
- 21 (e) The secretary of state may not adopt a rule modifying or
- 22 waiving the requirements of this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 213, Election Code, is
- 24 amended by adding Section 213.017 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 213.017. RECOUNT OF CERTAIN BALLOTS. During a
- 2 recount, ballots that do not comply with the requirements of
- 3 Section 85.0311 shall be counted separately.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 5 last day of the legislative session.
