**IN RE: HJR1** by Kacal (Proposing a constitutional amendment requiring a judge or magistrate to impose the least restrictive conditions of bail that may be necessary and authorizing the denial of bail under some circumstances to a person accused of a violent or sexual offense or of continuous trafficking of persons.), **As Introduced**

The fiscal implications of the resolution cannot be determined at this time due to the amount of state revenue reduction being unknown.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$178,333.

Based on information provided by the Office of Court Administration, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the resolution could be accomplished utilizing existing resources.

According to the Comptroller of Public Accounts, the resolution could result in a reduction to state revenue, but the amount cannot be estimated.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
