- 1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) by adding the
- 2 following SECTIONS to ARTICLE 2 of the bill and renumbering
- 3 subsequent SECTIONS of ARTICLE 2 accordingly:
- 4 SECTION 2.____. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 13.009. VOTER REGISTRATION THROUGH DEPARTMENT OF
- 7 PUBLIC SAFETY. (a) The voter registrar of each county shall
- 8 automatically register any county resident who is eligible to vote
- 9 as provided by Section 13.001 and:
- 10 (1) is issued a Texas driver's license or a personal
- 11 identification card by the Department of Public Safety; or
- 12 (2) makes a change to a Texas driver's license or
- 13 personal identification card issued by the Department of Public
- 14 Safety.
- (b) A driver's license or personal identification card
- 16 transaction with an indication provided by Section 20.062(b) or
- 17 20.063(c) that the transaction is not for voter registration
- 18 purposes is not subject to this section.
- 19 SECTION 2.____. Section 20.061, Election Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- Sec. 20.061. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER PROVISIONS. The other
- 22 provisions of this chapter apply to the Department of Public Safety
- 23 except provisions that conflict with this subchapter or Section
- 24 13.009.
- 25 SECTION 2.____. Section 20.062(b), Election Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- 27 (b) The department shall prescribe and use a change of
- 28 address form and procedure that combines department and voter
- 29 registration functions. The form must allow a licensee or

- 1 cardholder to indicate that [whether] the change of address is not
- 2 [also to be used] for voter registration purposes.
- 3 SECTION 2.____. Section 20.063, Election Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 20.063. REGISTRATION PROCEDURES. (a) The Department
- 6 of Public Safety shall consider an application made in person, by
- 7 mail, or online at the department's Internet website [provide to
- 8 each person who applies in person at the department's offices] for
- 9 an original or renewal of a driver's license, a personal
- 10 identification card, or a duplicate or corrected license or card by
- 11 a person who is eligible to vote as provided by Section 13.001 an
- 12 application for [opportunity-to-complete-a] voter registration.
- 13 The date of application is considered to be the date of submission
- 14 to the voter registrar for the purpose of determining the effective
- 15 date of registration [application form].
- 16 (b) The Department of Public Safety shall consider a change
- 17 of address that relates to [When the department processes] a
- 18 license or card and that is submitted to [for renewal by mail,] the
- 19 department [shall deliver to the applicant by mail a voter
- 20 registration application form.
- 21 [(c) A change of address that relates to a license or card
- 22 and that is submitted to the department] in person, [or] by mail, or
- 23 <u>online at the department's Internet website</u> [serves] as a change <u>in</u>
- 24 [of address for] voter registration [unless the licensee or
- 25 cardholder indicates that the change is not for voter registration
- 26 purposes]. The date of submission of a change of address to a
- 27 department employee is considered to be the date of submission to
- 28 the voter registrar for the purpose of determining the effective
- 29 date of registration [only].
- 30 (c) The registration of an eligible [(d) If a completed]
- 31 voter as required by Subsections (a) and (b) is automatic unless the

- 1 person indicates that the transaction is not for voter
- 2 registration <u>purposes</u> [application submitted to a department
- 3 employee does not include the applicant's correct driver's license
- 4 number or personal identification card number, a department
- 5 employee shall enter the appropriate information on the
- 6 application. If a completed application does not include the
- 7 applicant's correct residence address or mailing address, a
- 8 department employee shall obtain the appropriate information from
- 9 the applicant and enter the information on the application].
- 10 SECTION 2.____. Section 20.065(b), Election Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (b) Each weekday the department is regularly open for
- 13 business, the department shall electronically transfer to the
- 14 secretary of state the name and information designated by the
- 15 <u>secretary of state for</u> [of each person who completes a] voter
- 16 registration for each individual who is eligible to vote as
- 17 provided by Section 13.001 and applies in person, by mail, or online
- 18 at the department's Internet website for an original or renewal of a
- 19 driver's license, a personal identification card, or a duplicate or
- 20 corrected license or card [application submitted to the
- 21 department]. The secretary shall prescribe procedures necessary to
- 22 implement this subsection.
