12 (A) a county clerk;

13 (B) a permanent or temporary deputy county clerk;

14 (C) an elections administrator;

15 (D) a permanent or temporary employee of an  
16 elections administrator;

17 (E) an election judge;

18 (F) an alternate election judge;

19 (G) an early voting clerk;

20 (H) a deputy early voting clerk;

21 (I) an election clerk;

22 (J) the presiding judge of an early voting ballot  
23 board;

24 (K) the alternate presiding judge of an early  
25 voting ballot board;

- 1                    (L) a member of an early voting ballot board;  
2                    (M) the chair of a signature verification  
3 committee;  
4                    (N) the vice chair of a signature verification  
5 committee;  
6                    (O) a member of a signature verification  
7 committee;  
8                    (P) the presiding judge of a central counting  
9 station;  
10                   (Q) the alternate presiding judge of a central  
11 counting station;  
12                   (R) a central counting station manager;  
13                   (S) a central counting station clerk;  
14                   (T) a tabulation supervisor;  
15                   (U) an assistant to a tabulation supervisor; and  
16                   (V) a chair of a county political party holding a  
17 primary election or a runoff primary election.

18                   (4-b) "Federal judge" means:

- 19                   (A) a judge, former judge, or retired judge of a  
20 United States court of appeals;  
21                   (B) a judge, former judge, or retired judge of a  
22 United States district court;  
23                   (C) a judge, former judge, or retired judge of a  
24 United States bankruptcy court; or  
25                   (D) a magistrate judge, former magistrate judge,  
26 or retired magistrate judge of a United States district court.
