1	Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) by adding the
2	following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to ARTICLE 5 of the bill
3	and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of ARTICLE 5 accordingly:
4	SECTION 5 Section 13.038, Election Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 13.038. POWERS GENERALLY. (a) A volunteer deputy
7	registrar may distribute voter registration application forms
8	throughout the county and receive registration applications
9	submitted to the deputy in person.
10	(b) A volunteer deputy registrar may distribute application
11	forms for a ballot to be voted by mail throughout the county and
12	receive applications for a ballot to be voted by mail submitted to
13	the deputy in person as provided by Subchapter C, Chapter 84.
14	SECTION 5 Section 84.007(b), Election Code, is amended
15	to read as follows:
16	(b) An application must be submitted to the early voting clerk
17	by:
18	(1) mail;
19	(2) common or contract carrier;
20	(2-a) a volunteer deputy registrar, subsequent to a
21	delivery made to the volunteer deputy registrar under Subchapter
22	<u>C;</u>
23	(3) subject to Subsection (b-1), telephonic facsimile
24	machine, if a machine is available in the clerk's office; or
25	(4) subject to Subsection (b-1), electronic transmission
26	of a scanned application containing an original signature.

- SECTION 5.___. Chapter 84, Election Code, is amended by
- 2 adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
- 3 SUBCHAPTER C. VOLUNTEER DEPUTY REGISTRARS
- 4 Sec. 84.051. APPLICATION FORMS FURNISHED BY VOLUNTEER DEPUTY
- 5 REGISTRAR. (a) A volunteer deputy registrar may maintain a supply
- 6 of official application forms for a ballot to be voted by mail and
- 7 shall furnish the forms to voters throughout the county in a manner
- 8 consistent with law.
- 9 (b) A voter may submit an application for a ballot to be voted
- 10 by mail by delivering the application to a volunteer deputy
- 11 <u>registrar</u>.
- 12 (c) To the extent practicable, the procedure under this
- 13 section for distributing applications for a ballot to be voted by
- 14 mail and delivering applications shall be the same as the procedure
- 15 for delivering a registration application under Subchapter B,
- 16 Chapter 13.
- Sec. 84.052. DELIVERY OF APPLICATION TO EARLY VOTING CLERK.
- 18 (a) A volunteer deputy registrar shall deliver in person, or by
- 19 personal delivery through another designated volunteer deputy, to
- 20 the early voting clerk each completed application for a ballot to
- 21 be voted by mail submitted to the deputy, as provided by this
- 22 <u>section</u>. The secretary of state shall prescribe any procedures
- 23 necessary to ensure the proper and timely delivery of completed
- 24 applications that are not delivered in person by the volunteer
- 25 deputy who receives them.
- 26 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an application shall
- 27 be delivered to the early voting clerk not later than 5 p.m. of
- 28 the fifth day after the date the application is submitted to the
- 29 volunteer deputy registrar.
- 30 (c) An application submitted after the 15th day before the
- 31 date of an election and on or before the last day for a person to
- 32 timely submit an application for a ballot to be voted by mail for

- 1 that election as provided by Section 84.007 shall be delivered to
- 2 the early voting clerk not later than 5 p.m. of the next regular
- 3 business day after the date to timely submit an application for a
- 4 ballot to be voted by mail for that election as provided by Section
- 5 13.143.
- 6 Sec. 84.053. FAILURE TO DELIVER APPLICATION. (a) A volunteer
- 7 deputy registrar commits an offense if the deputy fails to comply
- 8 with Section 84.052.
- 9 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an offense under
- 10 this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 11 (c) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor if
- 12 the deputy's failure to comply is intentional.
- Sec. 85.054. ADDITIONAL TRAINING FOR DEPUTY REGISTRARS. The
- 14 secretary of state shall supplement the training under Section
- 15 13.047 to include standards of training in election law relating
- 16 to applications for a ballot to be voted by mail.
