2	relating to the payment by warrant of salaries of members of the
3	house of representatives and their staffs when a call of the house
4	of representatives has been ordered.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 659, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 659.086 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 659.086. SALARY PAYMENT BY WARRANT WHEN CALL OF HOUSE
9	HAS BEEN ORDERED. Notwithstanding Section 403.016 or 659.084 or
10	any other law, if a call of the house of representatives has been
11	ordered to secure and maintain a quorum, the comptroller may only
12	pay the net state salary of a member of the house of representatives
13	or an employee of a member of the house of representatives by
14	warrant. A warrant described by this section issued to pay a member
15	or the member's employee may only be delivered to the member:
16	(1) in person after government-issued photo
17	identification has been provided; and
18	(2) in the office of the speaker of the house of
19	representatives.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
