AN ACT
relating to filing of campaign treasurer appointments and campaign
finance reports with the Texas Ethics Commission.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Chapter 252, Election Code, is amended by
amending Sections 252.005 and 252.007 to read as follows:
Sec. 252.005. AUTHORITY WITH WHOM APPOINTMENT FILED:
CANDIDATE. An individual must file a campaign treasurer
appointment for the individual's own candidacy with the
<pre>commission[+</pre>
(1) the commission, if the appointment is made for
candidacy for:
(A) a statewide office;
(B) a district office filled by voters of more
than one county;
(C) a judicial district office filled by voters
of only one county;
(D) state senator;
(E) state representative; or
(F) the State Board of Education;
(2) the county clerk, if the appointment is made for
candidacy for a county office, a precinct office, or a district
office other than one included in Subdivision (1);
(3) the clerk or secretary of the governing body of the

political subdivision or, if the political subdivision has no clerk 1 or secretary, with the governing body's presiding officer, if the 2 appointment is made for candidacy for an office of a political subdivision other than a county; 4 5 (4) the county clerk if: 6 (A) the appointment is made for candidacy for an 7 office of a political subdivision other than a county; 8 (B) the governing body for the political subdivision has not been formed; and 9 10 (C) no boundary of the political subdivision crosses a boundary of the county; or 11 (5) the commission if: 12 13 (A) the appointment is made for candidacy for an 14 office of a political subdivision other than a county; 15 (B) the governing body for the political 16 subdivision has not been formed; and 17 (C) the political subdivision is situated in more 18 than one county]. Sec. 252.007. AUTHORITY WITH 19 MOHW APPOINTMENT FILED: SPECIFIC-PURPOSE COMMITTEE FOR SUPPORTING OR OPPOSING MEASURE. A 20 specific-purpose committee for supporting or opposing a measure 21 must file its campaign treasurer appointment with the commission[+ 22 (1) the commission, if the measure is to be submitted 23 24 to voters of the entire state; (2) the county clerk, if the measure is to be submitted 25 26 to voters of a single county in an election ordered by a county

authority;

- 8 earned on unexpended political contributions during the previous
- 9 year.
- SECTION 7. Section 254.205, Election Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 254.205. REPORT OF DISPOSITION OF UNEXPENDED
- 13 CONTRIBUTIONS. (a) Not later than the 30th day after the date the
- 14 six-year period prescribed by Section 254.203 ends, the person
- 15 required to dispose of unexpended political contributions shall
- 16 file a report of the disposition.
- 17 (b) The report shall be filed with the commission [authority
- 18 with whom the person's campaign treasurer appointment was required
- 19 to be filed].
- 20 (c) The report must include:
- 21 (1) the person's full name and address;
- 22 (2) the full name and address of each person to whom a
- 23 payment from unexpended political contributions is made; and
- 24 (3) the date and amount of each payment reported under
- 25 Subdivision (2).
- 26 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.
