4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.0171 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.0171. EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM ON SEX TRAFFICKING
8	AWARENESS AND PREVENTION. (a) Each school district shall provide
9	an educational program to students in grade six relating to the
10	awareness and prevention of sex trafficking. The program must
11	include:
12	(1) information on the different forms of sex
13	trafficking and the risk factors for sex trafficking; and
14	(2) the procedures for reporting sex trafficking or
15	suspected sex trafficking.
16	(b) Before the beginning of each school year, a school
17	district shall provide written notice to the parent of each student
18	enrolled in grade six in the district that includes the following:
19	(1) a statement that the district will provide an
20	educational program relating to sex trafficking awareness and
21	prevention of sex trafficking to students enrolled in grade six in
22	the district;
23	(2) a description of the material that will be used
24	during the program; and

3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2022-2023
4 school year.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 10 legislative session.
