- 12 (b) The governor may not issue an executive order,
- proclamation, or regulation that requires a person to wear a mask or 13
- 14 personal protective equipment unless expressly provided by
- 15 statute.
- SECTION 2. Section 418.108, Government Code, is amended by 16
- adding Subsection (j) to read as follows: 17
- 18 (j) A local official may not issue an executive order or
- proclamation that requires a person to wear a mask or personal 19
- 20 protective equipment unless expressly provided by statute.
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 22 executive orders, proclamations, and regulations that
- currently in effect, or go into effect on or after the effective 23
- date of this Act. 24

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
