## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to certain executive orders affecting public schools.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) Under this chapter,
7	the governor may issue executive orders, proclamations, and
8	regulations and amend or rescind them. Executive orders,
9	proclamations, and regulations have the force and effect of law.
10	(b) An executive order, proclamation, or regulation issued
11	under this chapter may not prohibit an institution of higher
12	education, school district, or charter school from adopting a
13	policy requiring the wearing of face coverings during a disaster.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18	Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
