## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a grant program to provide grants to law enforcement
3	agencies to equip certain motor vehicles with bullet-resistant

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 772, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 772.0079 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 772.0079. BULLET-RESISTANT WINDSHIELD GRANT PROGRAM.
9	(a) In this section, "criminal justice division" means the
10	criminal justice division established under Section 772.006.
11	(b) The criminal justice division shall establish and
12	administer a grant program to provide financial assistance to a law
13	enforcement agency in this state, other than the Department of
14	Public Safety, for purposes of equipping all motor vehicles used by
15	officers of the agency in discharging the officers' official duties
16	with bullet-resistant windshields.
17	(c) The criminal justice division shall establish:
18	(1) eligibility criteria for grant applicants;
19	(2) grant application procedures;
20	(3) guidelines relating to grant amounts;
21	(4) procedures for evaluating grant applications; and
22	(5) procedures for monitoring the use of a grant
23	awarded under the program and ensuring compliance with any
24	conditions of a grant.

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- 1 (d) Not later than December 1 of each year, the criminal
- 2 justice division shall submit to the Legislative Budget Board a
- 3 report that provides the following information for the preceding
- 4 state fiscal year:
- 5 (1) the name of each law enforcement agency that
- 6 applied for a grant under this section; and
- 7 (2) the amount of money distributed to each law
- 8 <u>enforcement agency that received a grant under this section.</u>
- 9 (e) The criminal justice division may use any revenue
- 10 <u>available for purposes of this section.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2022.
