15	students a virtual learning option through which students may
16	attend school virtually.
17	(b) A student enrolled in a virtual learning option under
18	this section shall be counted toward the school district's or
19	open-enrollment charter school's average daily attendance in the
20	same manner as other district or school students. The commissioner
21	shall adopt rules providing for a method of taking attendance, once
22	each school day, for students enrolled in a virtual learning
23	option.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 7 legislative session.
