- 2 relating to a vacancy in the office of senator or representative due

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 301, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 301.074 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 301.074. VACANCY DUE TO UNEXCUSED ABSENCE. A member of
- 8 the legislature vacates the member's office if the member is absent
- 9 during a regular or special session of the legislature without an
- 10 excuse granted in accordance with the procedures of the house of
- 11 which the person is a member for:
- 12 (1) seven consecutive days on which that house meets
- 13 and lacks a quorum to do business; or
- 14 (2) one day on which that house meets and lacks a
- 15 quorum to do business, if the member is outside of the United States
- 16 on that day.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 301.074, Government Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, applies only to an absence that occurs on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
