A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing that members of the
- 2 legislature are not entitled to receive a state salary, per diem, or
- 3 reimbursement for mileage for an unexcused absence when the
- 4 applicable house of the legislature lacks a quorum.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 24, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (c) of this
- 9 <u>section</u>, a member of the legislature is not entitled to receive any
- 10 salary, per diem, or reimbursement for mileage to which the member
- 11 would otherwise be entitled for any period during which the member
- 12 <u>is absent unexcused and the house of the legislature of which the</u>
- 13 person is a member lacks a quorum to do business.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2022.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing that members
- 18 of the legislature are not entitled to receive a state salary, per
- 19 diem, or reimbursement for mileage for an unexcused absence when
- 20 the applicable house of the legislature lacks a quorum."
