R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The thousands of deaths caused by COVID-19 in Texas
2 have created a tremendous void in families, communities, and
3 workplaces throughout the state; among those who lost their lives
4 in the pandemic was Jimmy Garcia, a dedicated and well-respected
5 employee of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, who passed
6 away on April 15, 2021, at the age of 56; and

7 WHEREAS, A proud veteran, Mr. Garcia served in the U.S.
8 Marine Corps for 15 years before joining TDCJ, and over the course
9 of his career with the agency, he was employed as a correctional
10 officer at the Neal and Clements Units; in his leisure hours, he
11 enjoyed fishing, working on cars, and doing carpentry projects;
12 moreover, he often gave freely of his time and expertise to help his
13 colleagues and loved ones; and

14 WHEREAS, Jimmy Garcia faithfully and ably performed his
15 duties throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal
16 Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all
17 who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
19 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of
20 Jimmy Garcia and extend deepest sympathy to his family, friends,
21 and colleagues; and, be it further

24 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Jimmy
