## RESOLUTION

7 WHEREAS, Born on February 28, 1964, in Belleville, Illinois, Frank Rose graduated from Hardin-Simmons University and received 8 9 his teaching certificate from the University of Mary Washington; he was employed for 27 years at the Windham School District, and he was 10 11 deeply respected for his work as a correctional educator for the district's pre-release program CHANGES; in 1992, he helped open the 12 Robertson Unit in Abilene, where he was teaching at the time of his 13 14 passing; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Rose was cherished by a family that included his 15 16 daughter, Sheridan, and his grandson, Ayden; he was also well-loved by his coworkers, students, and graduates, all of whom were 17 impacted by his gift for encouraging others to embrace positive 18 change in their lives; he was always overjoyed to hear about 19 20 graduates who had successfully met the challenges of reentering 21 society, and he used these stories to inspire his current students to work toward a brighter future for themselves; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Frank Rose faithfully and ably performed his duties 24 throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal

Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all
