R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The thousands of deaths caused by COVID-19 in Texas
2 have created a tremendous void in families, communities, and
3 workplaces throughout the state; among those who lost their lives
4 in the pandemic was Randall Sims, a dedicated and well-respected
5 employee of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, who passed
6 away on January 3, 2021, at the age of 57; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Sims began his career at TDCJ in October 1992
8 and was assigned to the French Robertson Unit in Abilene; he later
9 transferred to the Havins Unit before being promoted to sergeant
10 and then to lieutenant at the San Saba Unit; he briefly retired in
11 2013 before rejoining the Havins Unit in October 2017; and

12 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Sims enjoyed the love and
13 support of his wife of 37 years, Tina, and he took great pride in his
14 five children, Malinda, Chrystal, Jennifer, Randy, and Jessica, and
15 his 20 grandchildren; active in his community, he regularly
16 participated in livestock shows and other events that benefited the
17 Mullin Independent School District; over the course of his 28 years
18 at TDCJ, he served as a mentor to many and was highly esteemed for
19 his selfless and generous nature; and

20 WHEREAS, Randall Sims faithfully and ably performed his
21 duties throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal
22 Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all
23 who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
