- 16 participated in livestock shows and other events that benefited the
- 17 Mullin Independent School District; over the course of his 28 years
- 18 at TDCJ, he served as a mentor to many and was highly esteemed for
- 19 his selfless and generous nature; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Randall Sims faithfully and ably performed his
- 21 duties throughout his tenure with the Texas Department of Criminal
- 22 Justice, and he will long be remembered with great admiration by all
