the first class of Black students to complete all four years of

study at Warren High School; though he faced bigotry in those early

13 years of integration, he excelled in his studies and as a multisport

14 athlete; after graduating in 1976, he received a basketball

15 scholarship to Temple Junior College, and he went on to transfer to

Sam Houston State University, where he earned his bachelor's degree

17 in sociology and history; he later obtained a master's degree in

18 educational administration from Prairie View A&M University; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. White has enjoyed a long and accomplished career

20 as a coach and educator; after joining the faculty at West Brook

21 High School, he took the helm of the Lady Bruins basketball team and

22 ultimately compiled 350 wins as head coach; moreover, he also

23 coached volleyball and served as an assistant for West Brook

24 football and track teams that won state championships; he is
