1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories
2 of Arcadio Jesus Salinas Jr. of Rio Grande City, who passed away on
3 January 5, 2021, at the age of 70; and

4 WHEREAS, The son of Aurora and Arcadio Salinas Sr., Arcadio
5 Salinas was born on November 6, 1950, in Rio Grande City, and he
6 grew up with the companionship of a brother, Constancio, and a
7 sister, Lucia; answering his nation's call to duty, he proudly
8 served in the United States Army for more than 25 years, with
9 assignments in such places as Korea and Germany; he retired from the
10 military in 1993 at the rank of sergeant first class; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Salinas attended Pan American University, where
12 he earned both his bachelor's and master's degrees; he taught math
13 at Grulla Middle School for many years and went on to become an
14 at-risk coordinator and director of maintenance for the Rio Grande
15 City Consolidated Independent School District; active in his
16 community, he served on the boards of Starr County Memorial
17 Hospital and Starr County Teachers Federal Credit Union; in
18 addition, he was passionate about farming, and he grew calabazas
19 mexicanas for over 60 years; and

20 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Salinas benefited from the
21 love and support of his wife, Ruth, with whom he shared a rewarding
22 union that spanned more than four and a half decades; he took great
23 pride in their two children, Arcadio and Melissa, and with the
24 passing years, he had the pleasure of seeing his family grow to

1 include five grandchildren, Omar, Arcadio, Luis, Jorge, and
2 Christa; and

3 WHEREAS, Arcadio Salinas was a brave soldier, a caring
4 husband and father, and an engaged member of his community, and the
5 contributions he made in each of these roles will long inspire those
6 who were fortunate enough to know him; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
8 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of
9 Arcadio Jesus Salinas Jr. and extend sincere condolences to all who
