R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends were deeply saddened by the  
2 passing of Gregory Alan Lewis of Jacksboro on August 9, 2021, at the  
3 age of 54; and

4           WHEREAS, The son of Elzie and Lenora Lewis, Greg Lewis was  
5 born on September 20, 1966, in Jacksboro, and he grew up in a loving  
6 Christian home with three siblings, Gevern, Lynette, and Laurie;  
7 while in elementary school, he began mowing lawns in the  
8 afternoons, developing a strong work ethic; he graduated from  
9 Jacksboro High School in 1985 and went on to earn a bachelor's  
10 degree from Tarleton State University four years later; and

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Lewis enjoyed a fulfilling career as the owner  
12 of GAL Horticulture Services, where he pursued his passion for  
13 transforming properties through landscape design; an avid  
14 outdoorsman, he also found pleasure in hunting, fishing, working  
15 with cattle, and taking in the beauty of sunrises and sunsets; and

16           WHEREAS, On July 25, 1992, Mr. Lewis exchanged wedding vows  
17 with the love of his life, the former Jenilynn Barefield, with whom  
18 he shared nearly three decades of marriage; he was the devoted  
19 father of a son, Landon, and he especially treasured time spent with  
20 his family; a valued congregant of the First Baptist Church of  
21 Jacksboro, he served as a deacon, a Sunday school teacher, and a  
22 youth sponsor, and he was involved with numerous church ministries  
23 and community initiatives; and

24           WHEREAS, Although Greg Lewis is greatly missed, memories of

1 his strength of character, his abiding faith, and his dedication to  
2 his loved ones remain to comfort and inspire those he leaves behind;  
3 now, therefore, be it
